**PURPOSE**: The purpose of the scholarship program is to assist graduating Opp High School seniors in their pursuit of a post-secondary education at an accredited four-year college/university.

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**: Applicants must be graduating seniors from Opp High School in Opp, Alabama; have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5.

**SELECTION CRITERIA**: Selection of recipient(s) is based on such factors as scholastic performance while in high school, school and/or community service activities, financial need, and essay evaluation.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE:** Application must be received by the April 15, 2024 deadline. If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, the deadline is the first working day after April 15, 2024. Application must include the following:

- Completed application with signature
- Two (2) Character Counts recommendations
- Essay
- High School Certification Form with official high school transcript
